#### **New Business**

An application for an area variance was presented by Ronald Hamilton. The address for the area variance application is 5464 N. Old Bald Hill Rd., Hemlock, NY. The application is for a 12ft. X 24ft. shed. The placement of the shed does not meet the front set-back required, which is 50ft. from a road. There is only 20ft.

Chairperson Linda Moorhouse called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. She introduced the board members and asked Ronald Hamilton to come and sit before the board.

- L. Moorhouse Mr. Hamilton, you are on Old Bald Hill Rd. and you want to put in a new shed?
- R. Hamilton Yes, a 12 by 24 shed.
- L. Moorhouse Is the 8 by 8 shed still there?
- R. Hamilton One of them is and one is not.
- L. Moorhouse Ok, which one is gone?
- R. Hamilton The one by the house.

Showing the Board Members the photos, Mr. Hamilton pointed out the location of the shed that still remained on the property.

- L. Moorhouse So we need 50ft. and there is only 20ft., is that correct?
- R. Hamilton Correct.
- K. Scheele What is the distance between the new shed and your house, is that like 10ft.?
- R. Hamilton Yes.
- R. Hamilton pointed out the location of the well and septic system to the Board Members.
- K. Scheele Have you thought about another location?
- R. Hamilton I still don't have the 50ft. there. This location is very flat.
- K. Scheele OK.
- M. Gascon Are there any electric lines around that area?
- R. Hamilton No.
- L. Moorhouse If there are no other questions, I would like to entertain a motion to accept the application as complete.
- M. Gascon made a motion to accept the application, K. Scheele seconded, all in favor.
- L. Moorhouse The Public Hearing will be held here on June 10, 2015 at 7:30pm.
- R. Hamilton Ok, thank you.

An application for an area variance was presented by Connie Nagy. The address for the area variance application is 9684 Purcell Hill Rd., Springwater, NY. The application is for a 36ft. X 60ft. pole barn. The placement of the pole barn does not meet the front set-back required, which is 50ft. from a road. There is only 45ft.

- L. Moorhouse asked Connie Nagy to come and sit before the board.
- L. Moorhouse Why are you asking for a variance?
- C. Nagy We want to put up a pole barn and the back end of it will be 5ft. over the line.
- B. Best If you look at the pictures, they brought in a lot of fill on the south end and that is the corner that would be over the line. The south west is 65ft. and the south east is 45ft.
- C. Nagy and Bob B. showed the Board Members where the pole barn would be located on the property.
- K. Scheele What size is the pole barn?
- C. Nagy 36ft. X 60ft.
- K. Scheele Does it have to be that size.
- C. Nagy Yes, to hold our RV's and other vehicles. Then, she showed the Board Members where the septic, well, and electric lines were located.
- L. Moorhouse Do any of the other Board Members have any questions?
- L. Moorhouse If there are no other questions, I would like to entertain a motion to accept the application as complete.
- M. Gascon made a motion to accept the application, K. Scheele seconded, all in favor.
