IT'S EASY:

- Send your name and address, along with selected lakes and species from the list on the front of this card to fwfish8@dec.ny.gov.
- DEC will send you a diary for each lake.
- Record each trip and catch information in the appropriate diary.
- Send your diaries back to DEC in the provided postage-paid envelope at the end of the year.
- After we collect the information from the diary, we'll send it back for you to keep for your own records along with a summary report.
