#### A. CONVOCATION:

- 1. The Canadice Town Board Budget Workshop Meeting was held on September 23, 2019 at 7:00 pm at the Canadice Town Hall.
- 2. Roll call showed the following-

## B. PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

\*Representatives from the Richmond Fire Department and Hemlock Fire Department addressed the Board in regards to their budget request and possibly redrawing the district lines. Supervisor Singer used a 1% increase for Richmond as requested and 2% for Hemlock. For 2018 Richmond reported 17 fire calls, 124 EMS calls and 15 calls that were both EMS & fire in Canadice. As of September 1, 2019 there have been 17 fire calls, 94 EMS calls and 13 calls that were both EMS & fire in Canadice. After further discussion it was decided to meet in 2020 to discuss district line changes that would be recommended by Richmond and Hemlock. Supervisor Singer will provide some maps to help with the district line redrawing project. Chief Frost mentioned there will be a new brush truck and pumper truck delivered soon.

### C. BUDGET REVIEW:

\*Supervisor Singer provided the Board with a proposed 2020 preliminary budget.

\*Discussion took place regarding adding an additional person to the Highway Department. One suggestion was to start the fifth person in April to save some funds.

\*Superintendent Virgil mentioned the highway garage needing siding. Supervisor Singer indicated it would be a capital project and not listed in the budget.

\*The Richmond Recreation Department budget request was discussed. It was decided the increase should be 2%, not the approximate increase of 9.5% requested.

1. Resolution **Number 61 of 2019** – Setting Date, Place And Time For A Public Hearing To Entertain Comments Pertaining To Fire Protection District Contracts

WHEREAS, this Board desires to ensure the residents of the Town have adequate fire and ambulance services; and

WHEREAS, this Board will pursue executing new contracts for a one-year period commencing January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2020 that it feels best meets the needs of the residents of the Town; and RESOLVED, that this Board will conduct a public hearing to entertain comments pertaining to said contracts at 7:30 pm on October 14th at the Canadice Town Hall, 5949 County Road 37; and, be it further RESOLVED, that the Clerk of this Board publish notice of said hearing in the official newspaper in accordance with Town Law and send copies of this resolution to the Richmond Fire District and the Hemlock Fire District.

WHEREAS, appointed assessor terms are determined by Real Property Tax Law to have six-year terms,

WHEREAS, this Board has determined, after due deliberation, that Ms. Bennett has been and will continue to be an asset to the Town of Canadice; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board does hereby reappoint Ms. Lisa Bennett as Sole Appointed Assessor for the Town of Canadice for a term of six years to commence on October 1, 2019 and terminate on September 30, 2025; and, be it further

3. Resolution **Number 64 of 2019** – Setting Date, Place And Time For A Public Hearing Pertaining To The 2019 Special Assessment Roll To Collect Water District No. 1 Capital Improvement Costs Based On Benefit Formulas

WHEREAS, the Town Board has directed the Assessor to compute the CRC charge for the Water District on the 2019 Special Assessment Roll by applying a benefit formula that will be charged to each property within the Water District; and

WHEREAS, the Assessor has prepared and presented a 2019 Special Assessment Roll to the Town Board; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to hold a public hearing on the 2019 Special Assessment Roll; and, it is hereby RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Canadice that a Public Hearing shall be held on the 14th day of October 2019, at 7:30 pm at the Canadice Town Hall, 5949 County Road 37, Town of Canadice, County of Ontario, State of New York for the purpose of hearing public comment regarding the 2019 Special Assessment Roll; and, be it further
