Weed Harvesting Program Update – B. Landre, OCPD

The new shoreline weed fragment pick-up barge has been delivered and the team has had a chance to trial it out on the lake. There are some adjustments that will need to be made, but this was expected as this is a custom piece of equipment. The harvesting program continues to harvest and collect weed fragments both on a schedule and as people call in. The season will be ending early this year due to seasonal employee schedules.

Ontario County Soil & Water Conservation District Update – K. Lafler, OCSWCD

- DEC WQIP Grant application for the Town of Canadice for Flexamat road ditch projects on Cratsley Hill Rd and Canadice Hill Rd

The District continues to work on the application for WQIP which is due on July 30th.

- Great Lakes Restoration Initiative (GLRI) Forest Restoration Program Grant application for identification and treatment of Hemlock Woolly Adelgid

The District, along with many partners, submitted a GLRI grant to fund Hemlock Woolly Adelgid treatment in the Honeoye and Canandaigua Lake watersheds.

Town of Richmond/MRB DEC WQIP Grant proposals for Outlet Creek and Mill Creek shale removal and culvert replacement – D. Baker, Richmond

- The Town of Richmond is looking at what it will cost to remove accumulated sediment from Mill Creek and the Honeoye Outlet. A NYSDEC full assessment of the Mill Creek and the Honeoye Outlet watershed will be taking place soon.
