



The Ontario County Board of Elections is hiring Election Day poll workers to serve at poll sites across Ontario County.

Become an Election Inspector and you can earn up to \$310 for completing the training course, and working two Election Days!

Election Inspectors

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a registered voter residing in Ontario County
- Must be enrolled in the Democratic or Republican Party
- Must be able to read and write the English language

DUTIES:

- Must arrive 45 minutes before polls open
- Must prepare the poll site for voters
- Assist voters during the voting process
- Close the poll site
- Account for and document various secure items
- Assist other poll workers as needed

TRAINING:

- All Inspectors **must** attend a training class

SALARY:

- Earn \$100 for Primary Election
- Earn \$180 for General Election
- Earn \$30 for completing the three-hour training course

HOURS AND LOCATIONS:

- **Primary Election Day**, Inspectors must arrive by 11:15 a.m. and until polls are closed and results tallied, which will be after 9:00 p.m.
- **General Election Day**, Inspectors must arrive by 5:15 a.m. and until polls are closed and results tallied, which will be after 9:00 p.m.
- Must be willing to travel within your town/city, or within close proximity to your residence.
